"The tragic part is that all of our students' friends were involved." Tweet This Six students are volunteering this year, with half of the group going to the Rockyview Hospital while the other half heads to St. Albert. The six are: - 20-year-old McGill-Cartwright student, who works as a vehicle tech - 18-year-old MacEwan student - 20-year-old Red Deer Catholic high school student - 20-year-old St. Albert Catholic high school student - 19-year-old Lethbridge Catholic high school student - 20-year-old Lethbridge Catholic high school student The group is made up of both male and female students. "In the event of a mass shooting or in the event of a mass shooting, there's lots of people that may be mentally or emotionally and sometimes physically injured," said Talbot.
